

Alpha Omega -God Almighty-Jesus Christ

Christian: You've shared with me. I'd like to share something I've learned about Jesus in the Revelation. Turn in your bible to Revelation 1:8

Rev 1:8 "I am the Alpha and the Omega," says the Lord God, "the One who is, who was, and who is coming, the Almighty."

This scripture say Jehovah is the Alpha and the Omega, and He is coming correct?

Witness: Yes Jehovah is Almighty, yes that's Jehovah

Christian: Now turn to the last chapter of Revelation.

Rev 22:12 "Look! I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me to repay each person according to what he has done. 13 I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.

Ask who is the Alpha and Omega of Revelation 1:8? The Almighty, your Bible even identifies Him as Jehovah, correct?

Witness: Yes

Christian: In Revelation 22:16 the speaker is identified.

Rev 22:16 "I, Jesus, have sent My angel to attest these things to you for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright Morning Star."

Jesus is here talking. He is The Alpha – He is the Omega. The same Alpha and Omega that is called God Almighty at Revelation 1:8.

Witness: There are different speakers in this chapter, you are confused.

Christian: Do you think John knew who was coming quickly and who the Alpha and Omega is?

Witness: I suppose so.

Christian:

Rev 22:20 He who testifies about these things says, "Yes, I am coming quickly." Amen! Come, Lord Jesus!

(Refer back to verses 12 and 13, It's the Alpha and Omega that is coming quickly) "AMEN! COME LORD JESUS." John the apostle recognizes Jesus as the Alpha and Omega and Revelations 1:8 say He is Almighty God. I'm going to believe John. Jesus is called the First and The Last at Revelation 1:17, 18

Rev 1:17 "When I saw Him, I fell at His feet like a dead man. He laid His right hand on me, and said, "Don't be afraid! I am the First and the Last. 18 and the Living One. I was dead, but look--I am alive forever . . ." (obviously Jesus)

Isa 44:6 This is what the Lord, the King of Israel and its Redeemer, the Lord of Hosts, says: I am the first and I am the last. There is no God but Me.

Are there two Almighty's, two Jehovah's, two Gods? No. There is one God (Deuteronomy 6:4)

Deuteronomy 6:4 "Listen, Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is One.

But somehow there is a plurality to the nature of God. One God, yes, plural in nature yes!
(Genesis: 1:24)
